TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The Prairie Indian Rodeo Association is not capable of suing or being sued other than in connection with the legitimate business of the association.
- 2. It is agreed that the Prairie Indian Rodeo Association shall be released and saved harmless from any injuries, losses, or damages that may occur to the participants or volunteers of this rodeo.
- 3. Prairie Indian Rodeo Association shall supply the Rodeo Committee with an approved Rule Book.
- 4. Should a rodeo be multi-sanctioned, the rodeo association must be recognized and approved by the Prairie Indian Rodeo Association and the International Indian Finals Rodeo. The PIRA will act as host association in Saskatchewan following the PIRA rulebook. Administration Fee of 4% shall apply 3% to PIRA and 1% to other association(s) in Saskatchewan, which is calculated from the Payout Sheets.
- 5. The Prairie Indian Rodeo Association will provide the rodeo committee with all information concerning Prairie Indian Rodeo Association approved rodeos.
- 6. The Prairie Indian Rodeo Association will cooperate with the Management of the rodeo at which the Prairie Indian Rodeo Association members contest.
- 7. The Rodeo Committee shall guarantee the total prize money in CASH, which shall be made available to the rodeo arena secretary prior to the first rodeo performance and receipt issued to the Rodeo Committee in turn.
- 8. The Prairie Indian Rodeo Association Secretary shall take entries and call back along with acting as the rodeo arena secretary.
- 9. The Prairie Indian Rodeo Association Secretary shall submit to the Rodeo Committee and other co-sanctioning associations a copy of the Payout Sheets within one (1) week after the rodeo.
- 10. A Contestant participating in a Prairie Indian Rodeo Association sanctioned rodeo <u>must</u> be a member of a fully recognized Indian Tribe or Indian Band or Metis Nation and <u>provide verifiable documented proof</u>. A <u>status or Métis card issued by a First Nation or federal or provincial organization will only be accepted as proof</u>.
- 11. Entry Fees must be at least 10% of total prize money per event.
- 12. Entry Fees are payable in CASH prior to the first performance and Payout is payable in CASH at the completion of rodeo.
- 13. Judges names shall be submitted to the PIRA for approval. The Rodeo Committee is responsible for securing and paying the judges. As a guideline, their fee shall be no less than \$150.00 per performance.
- 14. Rodeo Committee shall provide and pay for an ambulance at all times during the rodeo performances. Rodeo shall not proceed unless an ambulance is present.
- 15. Rodeo Committee shall secure and pay for the stock contractor. However, the stock contractor must be approved by the PIRA.
- Stock Contractor shall be responsible for an Announcer, Pick-up Men, Timers, Bull Fighter, and sufficient Rodeo Stock, and payment of such.
- 17. Entry Dates shall be the Monday evening prior to the rodeo date(s) as stipulated above.
- 18. Entries shall be taken by the PIRA Secretary.
- 19. The Rodeo Committee shall agree to hold the first 11 major events listed above.
- 20. It is at the discretion of the Rodeo Committee to charge card-holding contestants gate admission.
